WHEREAS, on September 11, 2001, our nation suffered a tragic and unprecedented attack that forever changed the course of our history and the lives of countless individuals; and

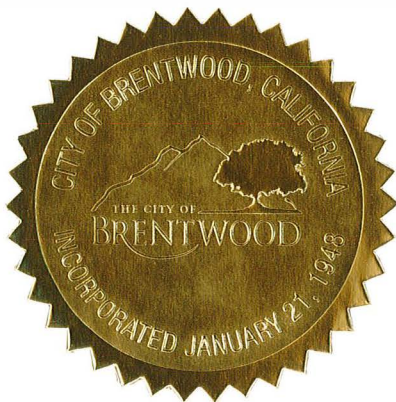
WHEREAS, Patriot Day serves as a solemn reminder of the lives lost, the heroism displayed, and the unity that emerged in the face of adversity; and
