On May 26, 2015, City Council took several significant actions related to the drought including:

- 1. Resolution No. 2015-80, declared a water shortage; and
- 2. Urgency Ordinance No. 950 and Ordinance No. 951 requiring mandatory water usage reductions; prohibiting certain water use activities; implementing administrative penalties for violations of water use regulations; and authorizing a water conservation rebate program.

On September 8, 2015, by Ordinance 957, City Council took several actions related to the drought including

- 1. Revising authorized water conservation incentives and a rebate program; and
- 2. Repealing Ordinance Nos. 950 and 951 if certain conditions are met.

On June 27, 2023, by Resolution 2023-89, City Council approved the amended 2022/23 – 2023/24 Operating Budgets, which includes \$165,000 in the Water Enterprise Operating Budget for drought outreach materials and incentives.

On July 25, 2023, City Council authorized staff to spend time and resources to research a funding source and budget implications for a new discount program for residential utility customers or to bring back the previous discount program for residential utility customers.
