WHEREAS, the VFW has exemplifies the principles of duty, honor, and service, inspiring us all to be better citizens and to uphold the values that make our nation strong; and

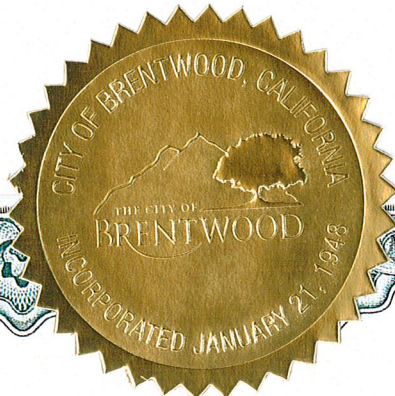


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, that the City Council of the City of Brentwood does hereby recognize September 29, 2023 as
