WHEREAS, the valor and commitment of our veterans have been instrumental in shaping the history and future of our nation; and

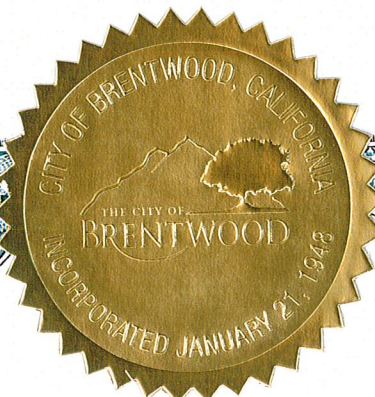
WHEREAS, it is our duty as a grateful nation to ensure that our veterans receive the care, resources, and opportunities they need as they transition to civilian life.
