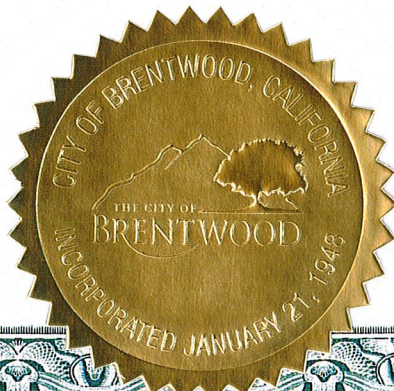
WHEREAS, we recognize the resilience, determination, and collaboration that have brought us closer than ever to a polio-free world.


NOW, THEREFORE, we, the City Council of the City of Brentwood, does hereby recognize October 24, 2023 as
