On October 24, 2023, the City Council, by motion, authorized staff to spend time and resources to develop a Race and Equity Commission to include stakeholders and elected officials, and that the Commission be tasked with the creation of a citywide racial equity plan, and from it, create an anti-racism and anti-hate crime policy.

On October 24, 2023, the City Council, by motion, spend time and resources to prepare a staff report to create a committee for Age Friendly Communities.

On October 24, 2023, the City Council, by motion, directed staff to spend time and resources to re-introduce the Budget Committee.

## **Brentwood Neighborhood Committee:**

On July 14, 1998, the City Council, by motion, approved the Mission Statement and 1998 Goals for the Neighborhood Advisory Committee as prepared by the Committee.

On August 10, 2004, the City Council adopted Resolution 2004-193, adopting the amended mission statement, membership requirements and the 2004 goals for the Brentwood Advisory Neighborhood Committee.

On June 27, 2006, the City Council adopted Resolution 2006-144 adopting the amended mission statement, membership requirements and the 2006/2007 goals for the Brentwood Advisory Neighborhood committee.

On September 9, 2008, the City Council adopted Resolution 2008-226, adopting the amended mission statement and membership requirements for the Brentwood Advisory Neighborhood Committee.

On April 10, 2012, the City Council adopted Resolution 2012-42, adopting the amended mission statement and membership requirements for the Brentwood Advisory Neighborhood Committee.

On July 26, 2016, the City Council adopted Resolution 2016-99 approving the restated Brentwood Neighborhood Committee Guidelines.

On December 10, 2019, the City Council adopted Resolution 2019-146, approving the restated Brentwood Neighborhood Committee Guidelines.

On April 12, 2022, the City Council, by motion, approved the revised Brentwood Neighborhood Committee's duties, goals, and guidelines.
