On July 12, 1994, the City Council adopted Urgency Ordinance No. 590, establishing a temporary moratorium on use permits for vending operations.

On August 23, 1994, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 544, extending the moratorium on the processing of new use permits for mobile vending operations for an additional ten months and fifteen days.

On December 27, 1994, staff returned to the City Council seeking direction regarding ordinance regulations pertaining to mobile vending operations. Council directed staff through the Planning Commission to develop an ordinance to regulate mobile vending operations.

On March 7, 1995, the Planning Commission adopted Resolution No. 95-08, recommending adoption of Mobile Vending Ordinance No. 551.

On April 25, 1995, the City Council conducted a public hearing on the introduction of Ordinance No. 551, Mobile-Vending, which was proposed by the Planning Commission to establish processing procedures, design and location guidelines for mobile vendors. The City Council declined to adopt Ordinance No. 551, and directed staff to develop an alternate ordinance restricting motorized vending to two hours per day per location.

On May 30, 1995, the City Council approved the introduction and waived the first reading of Mobile Vending Ordinance No. 554.

On June 13, 1995, the City Council adopted Ordinance 554, establishing business license requirements and standards for mobile vending with an effective date of October 1, 1995.
