

PREVIOUS ACTION(S)

- On March 22, 2022, the City Council unanimously voted to direct staff to return with an interim moratorium on oil and gas drilling in the city, while continuing to research and prepare an ordinance that will target all such uses within 3,200 feet of sensitive receptor areas, and permanently ban oil and gas drilling within city limits.
- On April 12, 2022, the City Council unanimously voted to adopt an interim moratorium on oil and gas drilling in the city, so that staff could continue to research and prepare a long-term, forward-looking ordinance that will target 3,200 feet of sensitive receptor areas, and permanently ban oil and gas drilling within city limits, if appropriate.
- On May 24, 2022, the City Council unanimously voted to extend the interim moratorium on drilling, for a period of 10 months and 15 days, in accordance with Government Code section 65858(a).
- On March 28, 2023, the City Council unanimously voted to extend the interim moratorium for a final period of one year, in accordance with Government Code section 65858(a).
- On October 10, 2023, the City Council received an informational update from staff stating that a revised version of the proposed ordinance would be returned to the Planning Commission for further review and recommendation.
- On February 13, 2024, the City Council held a public hearing to waive the first reading and introduce Ordinance No. 1067, approving RZ 23-003.
