Olberding Environmental, Inc. (Olberding Environmental) has conducted a review of the US Fish and Wildlife Service Wetlands Mapper, Geotracker Database Map, and FEMA's National Flood Hazard Map for the TA O'Hara Property (Property), located in the City of Brentwood, California.

LOCATION

The Property is located at the corner of O'Hara Avenue and Lone Tree Way at 7460 Lone Tree Way, Brentwood, CA 94513, in the City of Brentwood, Contra Costa County, California. The Property is located approximately 1.5 miles east of Highway 4 and bounded by residential development on the west and north, and by O'Hara Avenue and Lone Tree Way on the East and south, respectively.

RESULTS

<u>US Fish and Wildlife Service Wetlands Mapper</u>: The Wetlands Mapper integrates digital map data along with other resource information to produce current information on the status, extent, characteristics and functions of wetlands, riparian, and deepwater habitats. According to the US Fish and Wildlife Service National Wetlands Inventory, there are no wetlands, riparian, and deepwater habitats present on the Property (Attachment 1).

Geotracker Database Map: GeoTracker is the Regional Water Quality Control Boards' data management system for sites that impact, or have the potential to impact, water quality in California, with emphasis on groundwater. GeoTracker contains records for sites that require cleanup, such as Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) Sites, Department of Defense Sites, and Cleanup Program Sites. According to the Geotracker Database Map, the Property is not recorded as a site that requires cleanup (Attachment 2).


<u>FEMA's National Flood Hazard Map</u>: The National Flood Hazard Layer (NFHL) is a geospatial database that contains current effective flood hazard data. FEMA provides flood hazard data to support the National Flood Insurance Program. According to the NFHL, the Property is not within a flood hazard zone (Attachment 3).


