

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS; on April 17, 1952, President Truman signed a bill proclaiming the National Day of Prayer into law; and

WHEREAS, in 1972 that the National Prayer Committee was formed and went on to create the National Day of Prayer Task Force; and

WHEREAS, in 1988, President Reagan signed a bill into law decreeing that the National Day of Prayer should be held on the first Thursday of May; and

WHEREAS, the National Day of Prayer is a day when members of all faiths in the community can pray together in their own way; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, we, the City Council of the City of Brentwood do hereby recognize Thursday, May 2, 2024, as the

NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER

and invite members of the community to join in observing this day with appropriate programs, ceremonies, and activities.
