On November 16, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2005-276, adopting the Downtown Specific Plan, which includes regulations pertaining to outdoor dining in the downtown.

On January 8, 2008, the City Council adopted Ordinance 853, which included Standards for Outdoor Dining Uses and Merchandise Displays in the Downtown (DT) Zone (BMC Chapter 17.900).

On June 24, 2014, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2014-95, modifying various aspects of the Downtown Specific Plan, including minimal changes to the outdoor dining provisions.

On March 17, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-36, ratifying the Director of Emergency Service's proclamation of a local emergency in the City of Brentwood.

On January 11, 2022, the City Council authorized staff time and resources to research amended outdoor dining design standards, with approvals to be considered by the Planning Commission before returning to the City Council for final action.
