right-of-way for the Lone Tree Way Roadway Improvements, CIP

TITLE/RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a resolution approving and authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to execute an Agreement for Purchase and Sale of Real Property, with Brian Joseph Friedel for a portion of APN 018-100-031, to acquire road right-of-way for Lone Tree Way Roadway Improvements, CIP Project No. 336-31701 ("Project") for \$120,203, and authorizing execution of other documents as necessary to complete the right-of-way transaction.

FISCAL IMPACT

An appraisal has been prepared to determine the current market value of the 6,749 square feet of in-fee roadway right-of-way, in addition to compensation for damages to the property owner's improvements within the area to be acquired by the City. The total agreement amount is \$120,203 and the funds for this Project are included in the 2023/24-2027/28 Capital Improvement Program. The Project is funded by Development Impact Fees. There is no General Fund impact associated with this specific action. Any ongoing maintenance costs associated with improvements subsequently constructed will be budgeted for in future Operating Budgets.

BACKGROUND

The property is located at the southeast corner of Lone Tree Way and Smith Road. Acquisition of the right-of-way will allow for the widening of Smith Road and Lone Tree Way to accommodate traffic flow for the new Brentwood Union School District Middle School that is currently under construction on the east side of Smith Road. Once right-of-way is acquired, construction of roadway widening is anticipated to begin in summer 2024.
