A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD APPROVING THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, AWARDING THE BID AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT AND NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR THE PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM 2024 (CONCRETE), CIP PROJECT NO. 336-31703, WITH SANDSTONE ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING, INC. AS THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE AND RESPONSIVE BIDDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$378,110, PLUS FUNDING AUTHORIZATION FOR A 15% CONTINGENCY OF \$56,716.50, FOR A TOTAL FUNDING AUTHORIZATION NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$434,826.50.

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2023, by Resolution No. 2023-80, the City Council adopted the 2023/24 – 2027/28 Capital Improvement Program, which included the Pavement Management Program 2024, CIP Project No. 336-31703 ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, this Project is located at various city-wide locations and consists of the removal and replacement of concrete sidewalk, ADA ramps, driveway approach, curb and gutter; and adjusting utilities to grade; as well as construction a sidewalk along Spruce Street adjacent to Liberty High School; and

WHEREAS, the Project was advertised on February 28, 2024, and six bids were received and opened on March 21, 2024; and

WHEREAS, staff reviewed the bids received and is recommending the award of the contract for the Project to Sandstone Environmental Engineering, Inc. for submitting the lowest responsible and responsive bid.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Brentwood does hereby approve the contract documents, award the bid and authorize the City Manager or designee to execute a contract and necessary documents for the Pavement Management Program 2024 (Concrete), CIP Project No. 336-31703, with Sandstone Environmental Engineering, Inc. as the lowest responsible and responsive bidder in the amount of \$378,110, plus funding authorization for a 15% contingency of \$56,716.50, for a total funding authorization not to exceed amount of \$434,826.50.
