Brentwood and all of East County lost an amazing person this past February. Cecy Martinez has touched the lives of countless Contra Costa County residents, young and old.

Cecy is a local hero. She graduated from Liberty High School, went on to Cal State East Bay and has served our community since. As a former EDYSL, Impact, & Liberty High School and Cal State East Bay Soccer player, Cecy used her expertise to coach numeros soccer teams in our community.
