

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-32

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF ELEVEN REPLACEMENT VEHICLES (ONE FORD F150 TRUCK FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS WATER DIVISION AND TWO EXPLORERS AND EIGHT POLICE INTERCEPTORS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT) AND ONE NEW VEHICLE (FORD RANGER FOR THE PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT) FROM BILL BRANDT FORD IN BRENTWOOD, CA; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY ASSOCIATED DOCUMENTS IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$656,030 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023/24.

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2017, by Resolution No. 2017-17, the City Council adopted the amended City Council/Administrative Policy No. 10-9, Policy and Procedures for the Use of Vehicles and Related Equipment ("Vehicle Policy"); and

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2024, by Resolution 2024-09, the City Council amended the 2023/24 Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Policy 10-7 requires that purchases or services over \$50,000 be approved by City Council; and

WHEREAS, two new vehicles were budgeted for purchase as part of the amended 2022/23 - 2023/24 Operating Budget to support the Parks and Recreation Department to meet work performance needs; and

WHEREAS, eleven vehicles scheduled for replacement in FY 2023/24 in the Police and Public Works Departments were inspected and evaluated by staff who determined it was prudent to replace them at this time due to the wear and tear and elevated maintenance costs; and

WHEREAS, the one new vehicle will be purchased and the eleven vehicles will be replaced in accordance with the Vehicle Policy 10-9 and will encompass the purchase of eight Ford Police Interceptors, two Ford Explorers, one Ford Ranger, and one Ford F150 Pickup truck; and

WHEREAS, the bid from Bill Brandt Ford is the lowest responsive and responsible bid; and

WHEREAS, these purchases are in compliance with the Purchasing Policy No. 10-7 and the Use of Vehicles and Related Equipment Policy No. 10-9; and

WHEREAS, of the total \$656,030 cost, \$37,110 will be expended through the Parks and Recreation 2023/24 Operating Budget and \$618,920 will be expended


through the Vehicle and Equipment Replacement Fund, which are included in the City Council amended 2023/24 Operating Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Brentwood does hereby approve the purchase of eleven replacement vehicles (eight Police Interceptors and two Explorers for the Police Department, one Ford F150 truck for the Public Works Water Division), and one new vehicle (Ford Ranger for the Parks & Recreation Department) from Bill Brandt Ford in Brentwood, CA; and authorize the City Manager or designee to execute any necessary associated documents in a total amount not to exceed \$656,030 for fiscal year 2023/24.


