CONFERENCE WITH LEGAL COUNSEL- THREATENED LITIGATION  
Pending litigation; threat of litigation pursuant to Government Code Section  
54956.9(d)(2) and (e)(5)  
YIMBY Law and West Coast Home Builders

A closed session will be held on September 10, 2024, for the purpose of conferring with and/or receiving advice from your legal counsel concerning pending litigation; specifically, the threat of litigation. Based on existing facts and circumstances and the advice of its legal counsel, the City Council has received two separate statements threatening litigation against the City. *[Gov't. Code §54956.9(e)(5)]*. The documents memorializing these threats are attached to this memorandum and are likewise available for public inspection pursuant to Government Code Section 54957.5.

If the City Council accepts a settlement offer signed by the opposing party, the substance of the settlement shall be disclosed immediately following this closed session. *[Gov't. Code §54957.1(a)(3)(A)]*.

Any disclosures shall include the vote or abstention of each member.
