On December 12, 2023, the City Council directed staff to spend time and resources related to obtaining and installing additional flashing beacons, increasing the duration for flashing beacons, provide the most recent traffic study, provide traffic incident reports for 2022 and 2023, continue with landscape improvements, prepare budget opportunities if unsuccessful on grants, develop specific instructions for landscaping contractor(s), consider the installation of additional speed limit signs, and report on other things the City can do to improve safety.

On April 9, 2024, the City Council received a report on Vineyards Parkway and directed staff to:

- Paint speed limit on the pavement on Vineyards Parkway at locations deemed appropriate by the City traffic engineer (and potentially Vintage Place).
- Complete re-assessment of stop sign warrant to determine if any further conditions are met.
- Install stop signs if warranted. If not, return to Council with a report.
- Reduce landscaping 24-inches in height or greater where needed at the discretion of City staff.
- Continue seeking grants for RRFB's.
- As staff completes the tasks above, factor the existence of parks into work.
- Be proactive on Vineyards amphitheater mitigations or compliance with traffic standards.
