Actions were taken in previous years to form the City's 67 existing Landscape & Lighting Assessment Districts.

On March 23, 2021, by Resolution No. 2021-32, the City Council adopted a resolution approving and authorizing the City Manager or his/her designee to execute a Professional Services Agreement with Francisco for a two-year term, in an amount not to exceed \$229,900 per agreement year for assessment engineering services for Fiscal Years 2021/22 and 2022/23. In addition, the two-year agreement included an option to extend the agreement for two additional one-year terms.

On March 14, 2023, by Resolution No. 2023-25, the City Council adopted a resolution approving and authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute an amendment to extend the agreement for Fiscal Year 2023/24, for the first of the two allowable optional one-year terms in an amount not to exceed \$229,900.

On March 26, 2024, by Resolution No. 2024-29, the City Council adopted a resolution approving and authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute an amendment to extend the agreement for Fiscal Year 2024/25, for the second of the two allowable optional one-year terms in an amount not to exceed \$229,900.

On July 23, 2024, by Resolution No. 2024-78, the City Council declared its intention to 1) order the formation of, 2) levy and collect assessments for, 3) identify improvements to be maintained by Landscape & Lighting Assessment District No. 24-2 (Trumark Trailside) for Fiscal Year 2024-25 and 4) set September 10, 2024, as the Public Hearing date pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 and Proposition 218.
