A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD 1) APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") BETWEEN THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD ("CITY") AND LIBERTY UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT ("DISTRICT") REGARDING THE PUBLIC ART AND DESIGN ACADEMY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$18,630 2) AMENDING FY 2024/25 OR THE FY 2025/26 OPERATING BUDGET, BY INCREASING THE PUBLIC ART ACQUISITION FUND BY \$23,630 FOR THE COST TO BUILD THE ARTWORK AND FOR TRANSPORTATION, INSTALLATION AND LANDSCAPING OF THE PROJECT AND 3) AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE MOU AND MAKE MINOR NON-SUBSTANTIVE REVISIONS TO IT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE CITY ATTORNEY.

WHEREAS, the City desires to support the Liberty Union High School's Public Art and Design Academy ("PADA") through the available public art acquisition fund; and

WHEREAS, the Arts Commission has recommended to the City Council sculptures within the City of Brentwood by the students of PADA; and

WHEREAS, the sculptures', titled "Birds of Beauty" will be located in the planter box on the corner of Sand Creek Road and O'Hara Avenue in Brentwood, CA; and

WHEREAS, the sculptures' goal is to "create a beautiful art piece that complements the Tri-Fish sculpture in a stunning and natural way based on how nature operates"; and

WHEREAS, supplies for PADA to be used for the sculpture will cost \$18,630; and separately, \$5,000 for the transportation, installation and associated landscaping for the artwork, to be completed by City staff; and

WHEREAS, the City and the District desire to memorialize their relationship regarding the mural for Fiscal Year 2024/25 in a MOU to set forth their respective roles and obligations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Brentwood hereby adopts a Resolution 1) approving a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Brentwood and Liberty Union High School District regarding the Public Art and Design Academy in the amount of \$18,630 2) amending FY 2024/25 or FY 2025/26 Operating Budget, by increasing the Public Art Acquisition Fund by \$23,630 for the cost to build the artwork and for City staff to transport, install and complete landscaping of the project and 3) authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute the MOU and make minor non-substantive revisions to it, in consultation with the City Attorney.
