TITLE/RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council consider and discuss the request from Council Member Mendoza to remove 2001 Shady Willow Lane from the list of surplus land to become a park.

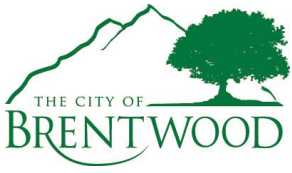
