## **PREVIOUS ACTION**

- On October 26, 2021, the Council discussed a future agenda item brought forward by Council Member Meyer related to implementation of the General Plan's Conservation and Open Space Element. At that time, the Council unanimously directed staff to add this item to the Strategic Plan process with an emphasis on prioritizing those actions remaining to be implemented. They also requested bringing the item back to the Council for a more in-depth discussion in February 2022, if feasible based on current workload of staff and Council.
- On December 1, 2021, the Council held a daylong workshop to discuss the Strategic Plan. At that time, staff made a comprehensive presentation with respect to, among other things, proposed goals and initiatives to be included in the Strategic Plan. One of the initiatives proposed by the Community Development Department was to "Protect Natural and Agricultural Resources." This included the development of an implementation plan for the General Plan's Conservation and Open Space Element, consistent with the direction provided on October 26, 2021 along with prioritizing remaining actions within their respective time frames and their associated cost.
- On February 22, 2022, the Council conducted a brief review of the Conservation and Open Space Element actions as part of a business item, but directed staff to return at a future meeting for a more detailed discussion.
- On November 14, 2023, the Council reviewed and discussed the action items contained within the Conservation and Open Space Element. Ultimately, the Council prioritized implementing action items COS 4i, COS 8f, COS 9f, COS 4f, COS 6b, COS 3c, and COS 9d.
