WHEREAS, this month serves as a call to action for all residents to raise awareness, support research, and honor the memory of those who have battled or continue to battle this disease.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the City Council of the City of Brentwood does hereby recognize the month of November as
