On February 28, 2017, by Resolution No. 2017-24, the City Council approved two viable locations for the Citywide Gateway Monuments "4-Corners" Project (later renamed Public Art Spaces).

On June 12, 2018, the City Council established a Citywide Gateway Monuments 4 Corners Ad Hoc Committee consisting of two City Council Members and two Arts Commissioners.

On April 23, 2019, the City Council approved two viable locations, artists and designs for the Public Art Spaces project, specifically naming Douwe Blumberg as the artist for the Brentwood Boulevard project entitled Fields of Time.

On May 14, 2019, the City Council approved the City public art location prioritization which indicated the site locations for Phase 1 of the Public Art Spaces projects would be Sand Creek Road across from Streets of Brentwood, Brentwood Boulevard alongside the Police Station, and Balfour Road Bypass median.

On May 28, 2019, by Resolution No 2019-68, the City Council adopted the 2019/20 – 2023/24 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) to include the Public Arts Spaces project.

On August 13, 2019, by Resolution No 2019-96, the City Council approved the execution of an artist services agreement with Douwe Blumberg for the Public Spaces project entitled Fields of Time on Brentwood Boulevard.

On May 28, 2024, by Resolution 2024-56, the City Council adopted the FY 2024/25 – 2028/29 Capital Improvement Program, which included the Public Art Spaces Project, CIP Project No. 337-37244.

On June 25, 2024, by Resolution 2024-73, the City Council adopted the FY 2024/25 – 2025/26 Operating Budget.

On July 23, 2024, by Resolution 2024-81, the City Council 1) approved and authorized the City Manager or designee to execute an amendment to the agreement for artist services with Douwe Blumberg for the Public Art Spaces – Phase 1 Project, CIP Project No. 337-37244 with a not to exceed amount of \$187,655 and 2) amend the FY 2024/25-2028/29 Capital Improvement Program

On January 28, 2025 by Resolution 2025-11, the City Council 1) approved the contract documents, awarded the bid, and authorized the City Manager or designee to execute a construction contract and necessary documents for the Public Art Spaces: Fields of Time ("FOT") Project, CIP Project No. 337-37244, to MARC Builders LLC dba MARC Engineering as the lowest bidder in the amount of \$79,942, plus funding authorization for a 10% contingency amount of \$7,994 for additional services, for a total authorization not to exceed amount of \$87,936, 2) amended the FY 2024/25- 2028/29 Capital Improvement Program for the Public Art Spaces CIP Project No. 337-37244 ("Project" or "Public Art Spaces Project"); and 3) amended the FY 2024/25 Operating Budget for the associated funding transfers.
